

PREVENTION & DIVERSITY ASSESSMENT (PDAT) QUALITY ASSURANCE TRAINING OVERVIEW

Summary

Training on what to look for and where to evaluate the quality/sufficiency of an initial assessment and plan in the Prevention & Diversion assessment format. It will also include an overview of key checks for Exit Planning.

Outline

OBJECTIVES : At the end of the course participants will be able to:

- Use a PDAT QA checklist and support tool to evaluate the quality of the assessment and plan
- Understand the key points to look for when quality assuring an initial PDAT assessment and plan
- Understand how to employ a flexible QA approach that allows for different levels of QA/audit depending on the time available and experience of the practitioner
- Understand how QA should differ for Exit Planning
- Identify wider working practice options and recommendations associated with ensuring consistent quality in assessment and planning practice

FORMAT : Attendees will carry out the following for each section of the PDAT framework:

1. Listen to an explanation of the completion and quality checks for that section on the QA templates provided
2. Review a case example and note feedback/suggestions on the template
3. The group discuss and ratify the feedback so that everyone is consistent in their understanding of “what good looks like”
4. Good vs. poor practice examples will be shared to support the discussion and application beyond the training

DELIVERY FORMAT :

2 x 3 hour virtual training sessions delivered through Microsoft teams with use of screensharing to review a case example. Attendees will be encouraged to complete QA forms so they can replicate their completion with local cases beyond the training.
